

CREW MANAGER INCIDENT MANAGEMENT COURSE (MODULE 7)

Course Code

CM IM

Aim

This module is designed to provide an individual with the functional requirements to manage operational incidents commensurate with the operational requirements of a Crew Manager on the MOD estate.

Summary of Training

The module is broken down into the following elements:

- a. Part A - Acquisition of Incident Management skills through attendance at a formal training module at DFTDC.
- b. Part B - New skills acquired during part A are to be further developed at station level with support and mentoring being facilitated by Watch/Station Managers and Regional Trainers (approx 3 months).
- c. Part C - Assessment of Incident Management skills through attendance at a formal assessment module at DFTDC.

Eligibility

Prior to attending Part A above, personnel must:

- a. Be a competent Firefighter, and
- b. Have been selected at a Supervisory Management ADC for enrolment on the CM Development Programme, or
- c. Have been selected for the Emerging Leader Programme.

Prior to attending Part C above, personnel must:

- a. Have successfully completed the Crew manager Module 1 – Operational Knowledge examination

Duration

Parts A & C consists of 5 days training

Course Content

The course currently covers;

- a. The Role and Importance of Command and Support
- b. Co-ordinating Information for Command and Support
- c. Environmental Risks and Control
- d. Incident Command 1 - Initial Response and Management
- e. Hazards and Risks - Buildings and Structures
- f. Dealing with Transport Incidents
- g. Dealing with Fire Incidents
- h. Dealing with HAZMAT Incidents
- i. Save and Rescue Endangered Life
- j. Treat Casualties and Support People at Incidents

Assessment

Assessment of the Crew Manager Incident Command Module is competence based with the aim that at the conclusion of the assessment personnel will have demonstrated the ability to Command and Control an incident safely in a given environment. The assessment Strategy is designed to establish whether each Delegate has the appropriate functional requirements to Command and Control Incidents as a Crew Manager on the MOD Estate.
